

Web Browser Settings for CentraOne 7.2

CentraOne uses Java, Java scripting, and ActiveX. We recommend the following Web browser settings on Centra Participants' PCs.

Netscape 4.5x, 4.7x, 7.0 or later (SSL events require IE 5.01 or later)	
Follow the menu path: Edit >> Preferences or File >> Preferences. Go to the Advanced tab	Enable all Java, Java scripting, ActiveX, and Cookies
Go to SmartUpdate	Enable SmartUpdate

Internet Explorer 5.0 and later.	
Follow the menu path: Tools >> Internet Options >> Advanced.	<p>Microsoft VM</p> <p>Select Java console enabled</p> <p>Select Java logging enabled</p> <p>Select JIT compiler for virtual machine enabled</p> <p>(Only JIT compiler is absolutely necessary.
